

Purpose.

This Cookie Policy forms an integral part of the Terms of Use and the Privacy Policy of the website, www.monpharme.eu, hereinafter the "Website". Accessing and browsing the Website, or using its services, implies acceptance of the terms and conditions set out in the Terms of Use, as well as in the Privacy Policy and, within it, this Cookie Policy.

In order to facilitate browsing on the Website, the owner of the Website, with registered office at street Huesca 7, 1º A 28903 Getafe- Madrid, informs users that it uses cookies or data storage and retrieval devices, DARD, or other files with similar functionality, hereinafter the "cookies".

In this regard, and in order to provide users with all the information necessary for proper browsing, the following information is made available on what cookies are, what types of cookies exist on our Website and how they can be configured or disabled.

What cookies are.

Currently, most websites, regardless of the service they provide, use cookies, meaning that they store minimal information about the user's use or browsing activity on the Website.

A cookie may be defined as a small text file or widely used device that is downloaded to the user's terminal equipment when browsing websites, for the purpose of storing data that may be updated and retrieved by the entity responsible for its installation in order to facilitate browsing and the user experience.

As Recital 30 of the GDPR states, natural persons may be associated with online identifiers provided by their devices, applications, tools and protocols, such as internet protocol addresses, session identifiers in the form of "cookies" or other identifiers with similar purposes. This may leave traces which, in particular when combined with unique identifiers and other data received by servers, may be used to create profiles of natural persons and identify them.

For this reason, the website owner maintains a cookie policy that is consistent with the applicable regulations.

As a general rule, when the installation and/or use of cookies involves the processing of personal data, whether first-party or third-party cookies, session or persistent cookies, the data controller shall provide the necessary information in this regard and obtain the user's prior informed consent to install and/or use them, except in the case of strictly necessary cookies.

Only cookies that are used exclusively to enable communication between the user's equipment and the network, and strictly those used to provide a service requested by the user, are exempt from such consent. For example, so-called technical cookies, such as those necessary for browsing the platform or application; personalization or configuration cookies, such as those that allow the page to recognize the user's language; and security cookies, such as those intended to detect repeated failed attempts to connect to a site, would be

exempt.

Types, purpose and operation of cookies.

Depending on the entity that manages the cookie.

First-party cookies: these are cookies sent to your device from the equipment or servers of the website owner and from which the service you request is provided.

Third-party cookies: these are cookies sent to your device from a computer or domain that is not managed by us, but by another collaborating entity or partner. For example, those used by social networks or by external content such as Google.

Depending on how long they remain active.

Session cookies: these are temporary cookies that remain in your browser's cookie file until you leave the website, so none are recorded on your computer's hard drive. The information obtained through these cookies is used to analyze website traffic patterns. In the long term, this enables a better experience, improved content and easier use.

Persistent cookies: these are stored on the hard drive and our website reads them each time you make a new visit. A persistent cookie has a specific expiry date and will stop working after that date. These cookies are generally used to facilitate purchase and registration services.

Depending on their purpose.

Technical cookies: these cookies are necessary for browsing and the proper functioning of our website. They allow, for example, traffic and data communication control, access to restricted areas, completion of an order purchase process, use of security elements, storage of content to broadcast videos or sharing of content through social networks.

Personalization cookies: these allow you to access the service with certain predefined characteristics based on a set of criteria, such as language or the type of browser through which the service is accessed.

Analytics cookies: these allow us to quantify the number of users and carry out statistical measurement and analysis of users' use of the services provided. For this purpose, users' browsing on our website is analyzed in order to improve the products and services we offer.

Advertising cookies: these allow the most efficient possible management of advertising spaces that may be included on our website.

Behavioral advertising cookies: these cookies store information on user behavior obtained through continuous observation. They allow browsing habits on the internet to be known and advertising related to the browsing profile to be displayed.
