Buttons

The buttons or links that must be included in the information banner (or cookie panel) for managing cookies are as follows:

- **ACCEPT COOKIES:** When clicked, the user gives consent for cookies to be installed on their device (required button).
- **MORE INFORMATION:** When clicked, this button allows the user to access the Cookie Policy to learn more about the cookies used by the website (required button).
- **CONFIGURE COOKIES:** Through this button, the user accesses the configuration panel for the various cookies they wish to allow or block (required button, although it may be located in the Cookie Policy rather than on the first layer).
- **REJECT COOKIES:** By clicking this button, the user rejects all cookies (this is not strictly required, but it is highly recommended to demonstrate compliance).

- Cookies may only be installed on the electronic device from which the user connects once the user has been informed and has verifiably accepted their use (such as by clicking the "ACCEPT COOKIES" button). Never, ever before that moment.
- The fact that the user clicks on the link to configure preferences or view the Cookie Policy can never be interpreted as the user's acceptance of cookies. The user may click to obtain information, whether they accept or reject cookies. The only valid method of providing this information is as indicated in the previous section.
- The website must always be navigable regardless of whether the user accepts or rejects the use of cookies. The only change should be in the tracking of the user's browsing activity; the rest of the site must remain fully functional.
- Access to a cookie settings panel is mandatory, where the user can select which cookies to allow and which to block.
- The information must always remain visible until the user takes one of the actions to accept or reject cookies.
- There must be a permanent link on the website labeled "Cookie Policy," where detailed information regarding the cookies used can be found, and to which the user must be redirected at all times if they click the word "here."
